The registration period ends: The Thursday, June 18th 2020 at 8 am EST.

The contest ends with the announcement of the winner: Thursday, June 18th 2020 between 8 am. and 10 am. EST.

All incomplete, illegible, non-compliant entry forms which have been submitted illegally, or which do not comply with the terms and conditions of this contest may be rejected. Only one entry into the contest per person is permitted.

2. Eligibility

This contest is open to legal residents of Montreal's Island who are eighteen (18) years of age or older at the time of entry into the contest.

Employees, officers and directors (including immediate family members and those with whom they are domiciled) of Les Marchés publics de Montréal and Panier Québécois as well as any affiliated company (such as described in the Canada Business Corporations Act) to partners ("affiliates") and respective advertising agencies and all other organizations associated with the contest are not eligible.
