



## CROWD COUNTING AND MANAGEMENT

On March 23<sup>rd</sup>, Montréal's Public Markets put in place daily crowd counting measures at the Jean-Talon and Atwater markets. This will allow us to provide our clients with the space required to maintain the imposed 2-metre distance from each other and our sellers. We would also like to remind our clientele that it is highly recommended to shop one person at a time.

### JEAN-TALON MARKET

- The market will be accessible only through the central hall doors
- Free outdoor parking is available under the canopies
- The underground parking garages is closed

### ATWATER MARKET

- The market will be accessible only through the north door to the market hall
- No changes to parking

### MAISONNEUVE MARKET

The following measures have been adopted at the Maisonneuve market:

- The indoor entrance to Jardins Dauphinais will be closed
- The store will only be accessible through the door leading to the parking lot

As previously announced, opening hours for the markets have been reduced to 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily.
